

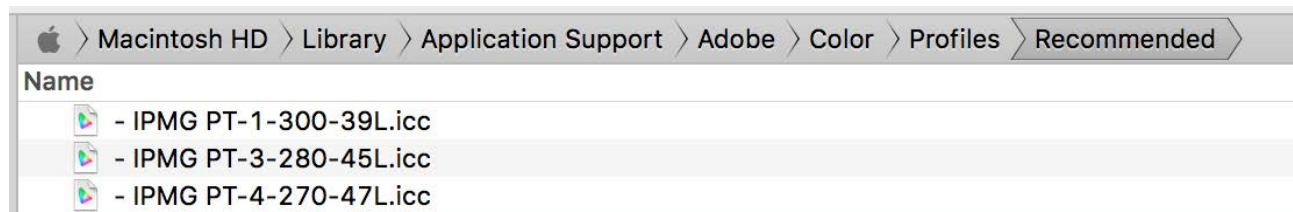

Setting up your Mac to Produce Print Ready PDF files for IMPG

SETTING UP YOUR MAC TO PRODUCE PRINT READY PDF FILES FOR IPMG

1. Install the Separation Profiles

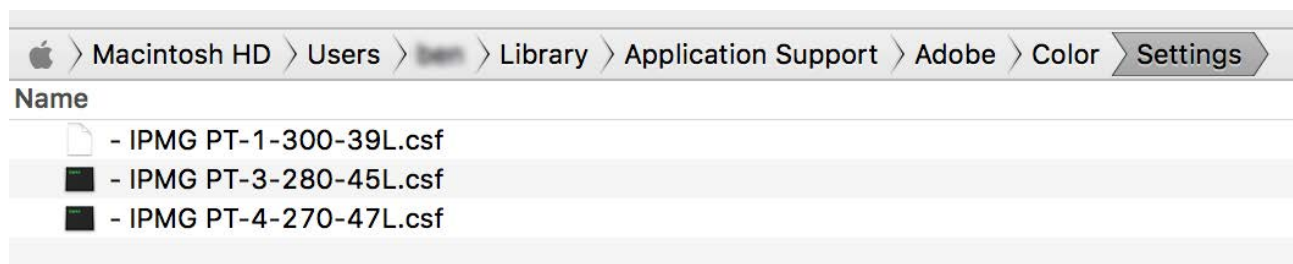
- 1.1 Open the downloaded **ICC Profiles** folder.
- 1.2 Select and copy the ICC profiles to: **Macintosh HD > Library > Application Support > Adobe > Color > Profiles > Recommended**



2. Install the Colour Settings Files

- 2.1 Open the downloaded **Adobe Colour Settings Files** folder.
- 2.2 Copy the each of the CSF files into the following folder: **Macintosh HD > Users > [Your User Folder] > Library > Application Support > Adobe > Color > Settings**

If you are having trouble finding your Library folder, in the Finder, choose **Go > Go to Folder**. And then in the Go To Folder dialog, type `~/Library`



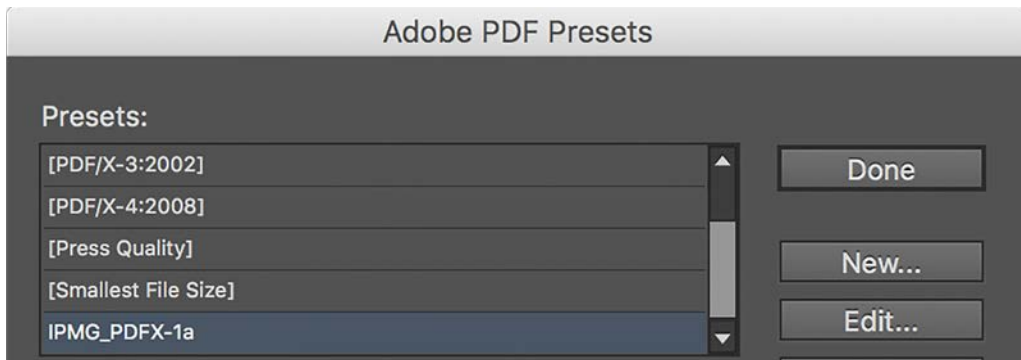
3. Load the Colour Settings

Colour settings are designed to optimise images for the paper type used in the printing process (PT-1, PT-3 or PT-4). Please check with your Sales Rep or Customer Service Representative if you are unsure which colour setting is appropriate for your print job.

- 3.1 Open Photoshop, go to **Edit > Color Settings** and select the appropriate colour setting from the **Settings** menu.
- 3.2 Click **OK** to commit the new setting as the default for Photoshop.
- 3.3 Open Indesign, go to **Edit > Color Settings** and select the appropriate colour setting from the **Settings** menu.
- 3.4 Click **OK** to commit the new setting as the default for InDesign.

4. Install the PDF Export Presets

- 4.1 Open Adobe InDesign, go to **File > Adobe PDF Presets > Define**, click on **Load** then navigate to the **IPMG_PDFX-1a.joboptions** file.
- 4.2 Click **Open**, then **Done**.
